





Guide set assembly

1. Open dragging mechanism.


2. Place the guide set and tighten the screws.



- **3.** Insert the guide set in the tool. You must leave a gap of 8-10 mm between cartridge tip and the end of the guide tube.
- **4.** Tighten the guide tube screw to block the position of the guide.



- **5.** Take the solder wire from the reel until the **6.** Close the dragging mechanism. guide tube start.





7. Connect the Auto-feed Iron to the station and switch it on. With the Iron out of the



stand, press the WIRE LOAD key till the solder leaves by the end of the guide tube


LOADING SOLDER WIRE



Clutch regulation

A. Adjust the dragging strength to allow the forwarding of the solder wire and to avoid stall and or clogging situations when any cause arises.

B. Tighten the dragging mechanism.



Driver gear replacement

When using solder wire within \emptyset 1,1 to \emptyset 1,8 mm you must use the Drive gear (Ref. 0002863) for dragging system. This gear must replace the one that is supplied with the station. To do that follow the next instructions:

1. Open the dragging mechanism.





2. Unscrew the clutch regulation assembly and pull it out.



3. Pull out the standard driver gear supplied with the station.



4. Place the new Driver gear (Ref. 0002863) supplied with the guide set.



5. Place the regulation assembly and screw it. Close the dragging mechanism.
